

Onslow School Uniform Policy

A school's dress code plays an important role in promoting a positive image of the school and creating a sense of identity and fostering a team spirit. It also enhances student safety because as part of their learning environment it is very important that all students are dressed appropriately so that they can be easily identified. This Policy aligns with the Department of Education Uniform Policy, which clearly states "No Denim".

Items below are available from the P&C Uniform and orders can be placed through the Front Office. For items marked * these will need be purchased from an outside supplier.

The garments available are as follows:

Primary Uniform

Girls Uniform:

K – 2 school dress with appropriate undergarment for when students are sitting on

the mat, e.g., bike shorts*

General Navy polo shirt with school logo, navy shorts, navy skorts

Boys Uniform:

General Navy polo shirt with school logo, navy shorts

Secondary Uniform

General: Navy polo shirt with school logo and orange strip at the side, navy shorts

Whole School

Hats navy broad brimmed (6cm brim) hat, navy bucket hat*, navy legionnaires hat*,

cap * (Secondary only)

Other

Sport Shirts to be worn by students on designated day as decided by the school, including

interschool events.

Jewellery: Any jewellery worn by students needs to be appropriate and inoffensive to

others. It is preferred that jewellery not be worn in case of injury, loss or theft.

Shoes: All footwear* to be appropriate for the activities provided at the school. Thongs

healed and open backed sandals are not considered appropriate. For students accessing Home Economics and Design & Technology rooms

footwear MUST be enclosed shoes.

NOTE: Windcheaters (where navy windcheaters available from the P&C Uniform

Shop) can be worn during the cooler months.
